Lamb Secure is a non-medicated buffer, mineral, vitamin and additive concentrate pellet that has been specifically formulated to be added to grain and legumes. It is designed to be fed to lambs in the feedlot, containment area, or as a grain-assist in the paddock.



Lamb Secure has been specially designed to focus on:

- ✓ Rumen health to reduce the risk of acidosis and promote a functional rumen environment.
- ✓ Urinary tract health to reduce the incidence of urinary calculi.
- ✓ An active immune system to aid adaptation to the feedlot.
- ✓ Optimum frame development, muscle health and key metabolic processes for growth.
- ✓ Reducing vitamin deficiencies i.e., B1 deficiency (PEM), vitamins A & E when feeding grain.



Natural anti-microbial protection: the inclusion of plant compounds from the oregano plant has been shown to improve intestinal health, promote beneficial bacteria and reduce the incidence of pathogens. Regano® is a safe, natural product with no withholding period. It is acceptable for use where nil ionophore are required for farm assurance programs.



Ingredients: (selected from): Cereals and cereal co-products, calcium carbonate, acid buf, dicalcium phosphate, anionic salts, yeast culture, TLC Lamb Feedlot Premix (including organic chromium, cobalt, copper, iodine, iron, manganese, organic selenium, organic zinc, vitamins A, E, B1, bioavailable vitamin D), salt, Regano®, canola oil, molasses.

Feeding guide: Add **Lamb Secure** to grain at 50kg per tonne (2 x 25kg bags)

To blend a 16% protein grain mix, using barley at 10-11% protein:

Addition per tonne = 750kg barley, 200kg lupins, 50kg Feedlot Essentials.

- 1) Trail feed grain mix in yard at 100g/head and increase by 100g every 2nd day for 14 days
- 2) Fill self-feeder and allow access with slides set at approx. 5-8mm. Some grain in the tray will help lambs learn it's a feed source. After 5-7 days, slides can be opened to 8-10mm to allow increased access to grain mix, to increase daily feed intake and growth rates.
- 3) Always provide palatable roughage and fresh water.
